

**Expenses of childcare:**

Expenses of childcare are to claim in form F *Expenses of childcare*.  
The expenses are deductible for parents, who are not able to take care of their children themselves because of employment, education or disability.

Spouses can only claim the deductions if they are both not able to take care of their children. If one of them is working part time, we cannot guarantee that the tax office will accept this. We would need to get written confirmation first from the tax office.

Deductible are expenses for childcare done by a third person (day centre, child nanny for example).

You have to prove the expenses with certifications of the tax year that is done by the particular company/institution/person.

Deductible are expenses up to CHF 10'000.– in canton respectively 10'100 in federal.

The Deduction is only possible until the 14<sup>th</sup> birthday of the child.
